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Submission of contributions

Who can submit a contribution?

All students who have conducted research through their Bachelor, Master or Doctoral studies are eligible to submit a research paper. This includes students from CTL Eurocollege and the Cyprus University of Technology.

One contribution per student can be presented. If more than one contribution is desired or necessary, please contact Dr. Maria Hadjielia, PhD before submitting the contribution(s): hadjieliadrm@ctleuro.ac.cy

What are possible contributions at the conference?

- Short presentation: Student research may be presented at the conference in a short talk. The presentation should last approximately 10 to 15 minutes. With subsequent chairpersons and plenary discussion, presenters will have a maximum of 20 minutes in total.
- Innovative/Entrepreneurship/Business/Digital/Tourism/Hospitality/Comp uting Contribution: Student research may be presented as part of an innovative, entrepreneurship, business, digital, tourism & hospitality, computing, or artifact-based contribution. In the case of a lecture-type presentation format, the time specifications for short presentations apply, i.e., 20 minutes total (10 to 15 minutes presentation followed by discussion).

What should be urgently considered when submitting contributions?

A short abstract (max. 2,500 characters including spaces) must be submitted to present the conference contribution. The following notes provide more detailed information on what should be considered in this abstract:

1. Content

• The abstract should clearly state what the specific research question or topic is, why the question or topic is relevant, what the process or design of the





research project was, what methodology was used, what results were obtained (or are expected), and what possible follow-up questions arise from the student research project.

• It is important to note that the research does not have to be completed yet. Interim results are also welcome to be presented. The abstract is also not set in stone, i.e., if there are changes between now and the conference itself, that's fine.

2. Comprehensibility

• Since the Student Research Conference is multidisciplinary, the abstract should be comprehensible also for people from other disciplines.

3. Length

• The abstract can be a maximum of 2,500 characters long (including spaces). Literature references and citations are not necessary.

4. <u>Language</u>

• The abstract can be submitted in English.

How can the contribution be submitted?

Contributions can easily be submitted via an online form (it will be given in a later stage). Via this form, information about the submitting persons can be given and the abstract of the student research project can be uploaded.

When is the deadline for submission of contributions?

The deadline for submission is **November 30th, 2023**.





Venue and time

The Student Research Conference 2024 will take place on **January 30th, 2024** at the CTL Eurocollege, Limassol, Cyprus. The venue is the building of the college's campus at **118 Spyros Kyprianou Ave., 3077 Limassol**, covering the **floor 1 and 2**.
